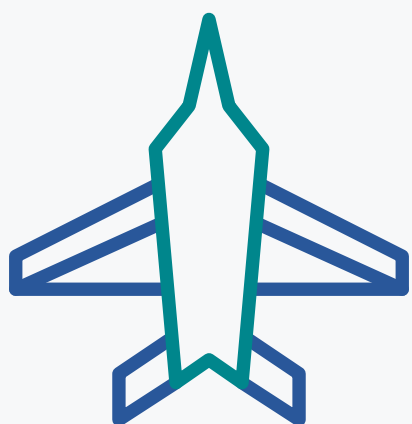


In Canada, law-making powers are divided between four orders of government. Here are some of their responsibilities:

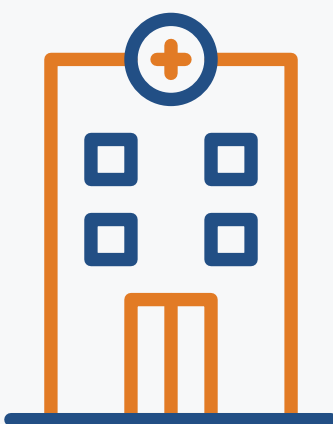

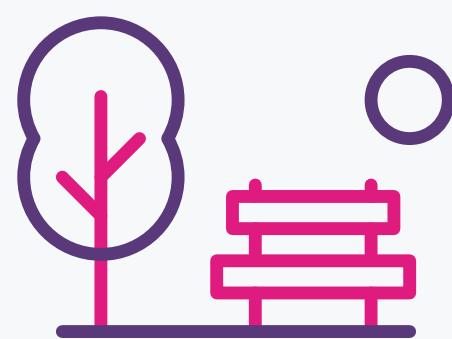

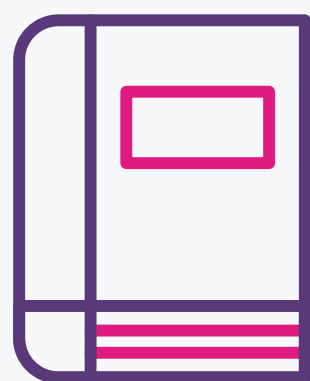
