## The Coats of Arms

The galleries display eight coats of arms – seven for the provinces at the time the Library opened and one for Canada.

## The Statue of Queen Victoria

The statue of Queen Victoria situated at the centre of the Main Library was carved by Marshall Wood from a block of white marble. It is 3.45 metres tall and weighs about 3,500 kilograms.



## The Dome

The Library's dome measures 47.2 metres in diameter and 40.2 metres from the floor to its top.

## The Wood Panelling

The Library's wood panelling includes more than 1,600 designs, featuring flowers, masks and mythical beasts.
